While much of Bangladesh is flat, Srimangal is well known for its gently rolling landscape, much of which is covered in a fine green quilt of tea plantations. Owing to the tea trees, Srimangal is also known as the city of two leaves and one bud. All tea plantation workers are actually from India, originally brought to the region by the British, and the work is passed down from generation to generation. One of the most famous tea plantations in the region is the Zareen Tea Plantation, whose Ispahani tea is renowned across Bangladesh. While tea was once a large export for Bangladesh, there is so much internal national demand that there is no need to export and almost all tea is sold within the country.
