Hanging Bridge at Rangamati



Chittagong is the biggest seaport and second largest town in Bangladesh situated near the Bay of Bengal. It is 264 km east of the Capital City Dhaka. It is well known for hill areas, natural beauty and the seashore. Chittagong is also known as the town of Aulias (Muslim saints).

Hanging Bridge is the main attraction of Rangamati city, this 335-foot-long bridge in Kaptai Lake is one of the most spectacular sites in Bangladesh. This bridge is called '**Symbol of Rangamati**'. The hanging bridge has been built between two isolated hills in the heartland. Here you can see the beautiful scenery of Kaptai Lake. Adivasi village is situated on the other side. During the rainy season, the bridge is submerged under water.
