Establish an Intergenerational platform for learning: Age Stereotyping

Title: Challenging the concepts and views of younger and older people

Aim: To explore positive and negative stereotypical ideas around youth and ageing.

Objective: This exercise provides the group of participants with a selection of images portraying younger and older people in negative and positive ways.

Guidance: Look at the images of younger and older people. Examine the images carefully, then take a pen and some *post it notes* and write down words to describe what you see and feel about some of the pictures. This is done in age specific groups) Stick your posts on the pictures you have chosen to comment on.

Coding of 'Post it' responses: Collate the information into positive and negative responses. Initiate discussions around – What is old or young? How does that look and feel....What can older people/younger do? How do others describe older/younger people...

Concepts Explored:

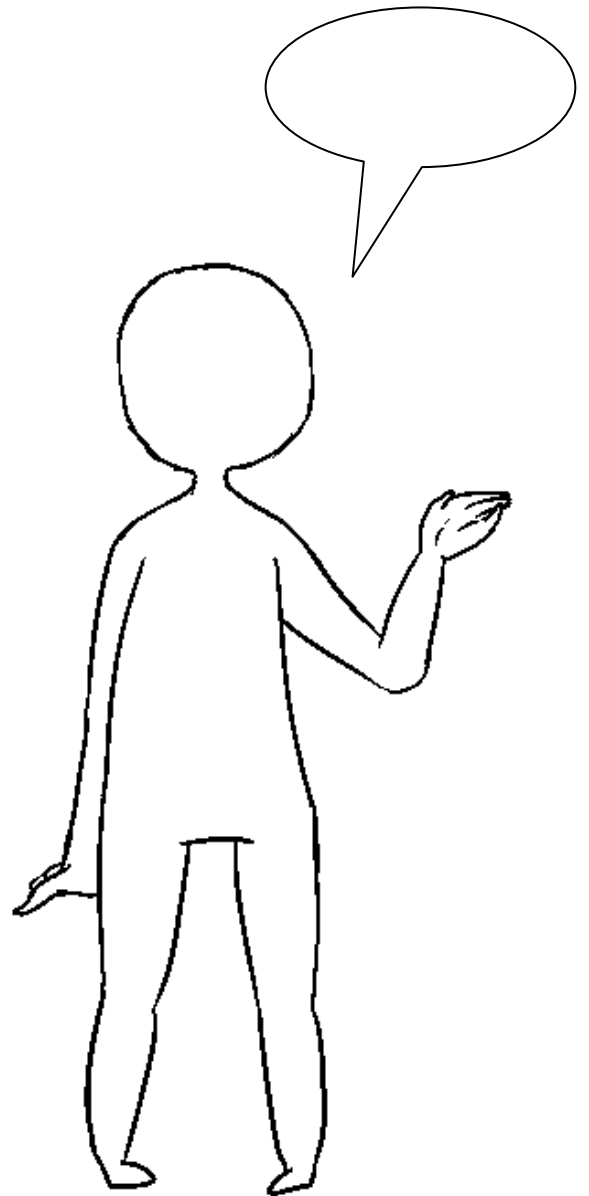
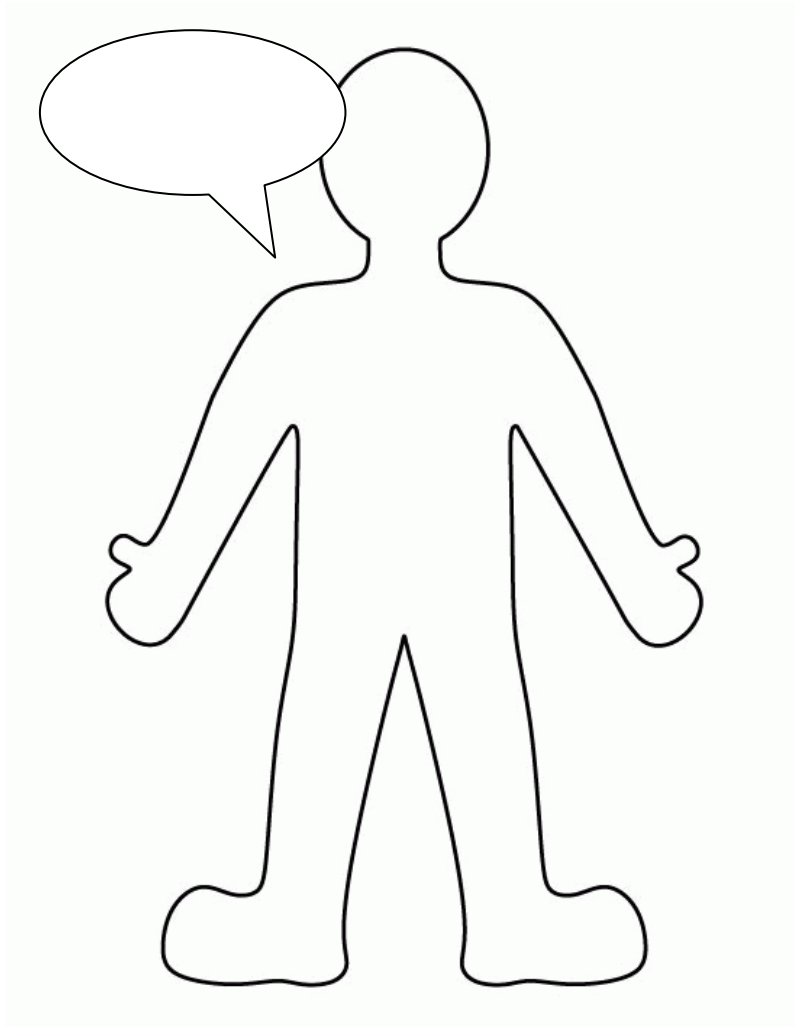
1. **The Intergenerational Relationship Images:** What are the positive and negative responses? Is there any exchange/learning taking place?
 2. **Attitudes to lifespan.** Age – What is Old – What is too young – Too Old?
