Syedpur to Sunderland: An Intergenerational Journey Chittagong চট্টগ্রাম, Cox's Bazar







Cox's Bazar Beach in Bangladesh is one of the largest uninterrupted natural sandy sea beaches found throughout the entire world. It stretches to a total of 120 kilometres (74 miles) in length.

The beach takes its name from Captain Hiram Cox, an officer who served in the British East India Company and defeated the Burmese king in the year 1799, who set up a large seaside Bazar market. Over 90 kilometres (55 miles) of the beach is surrounded by beautiful hillside as well as several other areas that include large Buddhist temples, huge cliffs and unbroken forested area.

The waters at this beach are teeming with sea life creatures including jellyfish, starfish, numerous fish species and also two different types of rare sea turtles.
